Local Concern

- The unintentional poisoning death rate in Sarasota County for persons aged 25-34 years old, has consistently remained higher than the State's average since 2010.
- Unintentional injury remains the leading cause of death among 25-34 year olds (FL Charts, 2014)
- The highest rate of unintentional poisoning deaths in Sarasota County occurred among 25-34 year olds (FLDOH Vital Statistics, 2015)
 - The majority of unintentional poisonings for this age group are related to prescription drugs abuse and misuse.

Anyone who prescribes, dispenses, or stores controlled substances is encouraged to attend this educational opportunity. This educational platform will present a framework for safely prescribing opioids.
