More than 130 health professionals to get updates on HPV and other adolescent vaccines

SARASOTA COUNTY — More than 130 public health and health care providers from counties around Florida are registered to attend the 8th Annual Southwest Florida Immunization Workshop entitled, "Facing the Challenge— Adolescent Vaccinations." The goal is to share best-practice strategies to increase adolescent vaccination rates, with a special emphasis on the Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) vaccine, known to prevent a number of cancers, including most forms of cervical cancer.
