SARASOTA, FL — The Florida Department of Health in Sarasota County’s (DOH-Sarasota) Health In Motion staff will provide no-cost health screenings and referrals for general health and wellness during December. The Registered Nurse (RN) also helps individuals who lack medical insurance find a medical home for ongoing health care through referrals to the Community Health Centers of Sarasota County.

Health In Motion services include:

- Diabetes - glucose screening
- Tips for staying healthy
- Individual Health education
- Referrals to “Quit Your Way” with Tobacco Free Florida
- Referrals to Community Health Centers of Sarasota County for ongoing health care
